HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY

The Hibbing City Council, by statute, has the power to regulate its own procedure. The Council has established a procedure allowing citizens to address the Council at regular meetings on issues pertaining to City of Hibbing business and not otherwise on the agenda for a particular meeting. This portion of the meeting is called the "Citizen's Forum". Each citizen has five (5) minutes to address the issues. To be placed on the Citizen's Forum, each citizen must sign up before the meeting starts by completing this form.

The Council, and therefore the City of Hibbing, will have no prior knowledge of what a citizen may say during the "Citizen's Forum". The responsibility for what is said by a citizen is solely that of the citizen. The citizen understands that the following must not be discussed during the Citizen's Forum:

- 1) Advertising materials or statements,
- 2) Obscene, libelous, or slanderous materials or statements, or
- 3) Lottery or lottery information

The undersigned assumes full responsibility for statements made by the undersigned during the "Citizen's Forum" and agrees to hold the City of Hibbing and the individual Council members harmless from any and all liability arising out of the citizen's statements and agrees to indemnify the City of Hibbing and the individual Council members for any loss or damages arising from such statements.
